Positioned where the Atlantic and Caribbean meet in the Leeward Islands, Antigua is known for breathtaking natural scenery, candy cane coloured villages, bustling resorts and picture perfect, fine white sand, reef-lined beaches (one for every day of the year - even leap years!). There's also a rich and diverse cultural heritage along with world class historic sites and, of course, there's cricket - this is the West Indies after all!

Our panoramic tour starts with the capital St. John's pointing out some historical landmarks. While passing through the villages and sites your guide will supply detailed local history and answer any questions. We stop for sightseeing, drinks and souvenir shopping at the historic Block House Ruins and Shirley Heights, a stunning photo opportunity with amazing views from 446 feet above sea level.

Next we explore Nelsons Dockyard, a beautifully preserved historic site which was recognised by Unesco in 2016. Finally, following a drive through our tropical rain forest, we make a beach stop at the famous Valley Church beach, one of Antigua's most beautiful beaches with fine white sand and clear aquamarine water. Beach time is 2-3hrs depending on duration of the tour and cruise departure time.

EASTERN ATLANTIC CRICKET AND SIGHTSEEING TOUR

This is *the* tour for cricket lovers - *don't panic* – sightseers and beach lovers are not left out! Starting from the capital St. John's, pointing out some historical landmarks, we visit Antigua Recreation Grounds, former home of test cricket in Antigua, where Brian Lara set a test record of 400 in 2004. Now sadly run down, but still very atmospheric.

From here we head to the former Stanford Cricket Ground which was rebuilt in 2004 by American billionaire Allen Stanford and is home to the West Indies Cricket Hall of Fame. The stadium was renamed Coolidge Cricket Ground in 2016 but is still known locally as 'The Sticky Wicket'! Our next stop will be the Sir Vivian Richard Stadium, named after the legendary West Indies captain, established as the National Stadium of

Our next stop will be the Sir Vivian Richard Stadium, named after the legendary West Indies captain, established as the National Stadium of Antigua and Barbuda to replace the old recreation grounds in 2007. After passing through local villages and getting a detailed history, we will visit Devil's Bridge, a natural historic heritage site with a blow hole. Our final stop will be at Long Bay for snorkelling and beach time.

Please Note - occasionally, due to training or match preparation, our access to one or other of the grounds may be restricted with very little warning. In this case we will spend extra time at the other tour stops. Includes - Drinks (water, local beers, sodas and the famous Antigua Rum punch) and entrance fees to all sites.

Fifteen miles north of the coast of Venezuela and known universally as 'One Happy Island', Aruba is said to have more sunny days than any other Caribbean island. A flat island with no rivers, renowned for its white sand beaches and tropical climate moderated by constant trade winds, Aruba lies outside the Caribbean hurricane belt.

First stop on the tour will be our unique Aruba Aloe factory and museum, your guide will show you first hand how Aloe is grown, harvested, extracted and how the final Aloe products are produced and used. All Aruba Aloe body, sun and hair care products can be purchased in the factory store.

Then we will visit the unique rock formations of Casibari and Ayo. Your knowledgeable and entertaining guide will climb with you to the top of Casibari to show you his Aruba in a 360-degree panoramic view. At Ayo you will see pre-Columbian Arawak Indian paintings dating back thousands of years.



On the way to the site of the Natural Bridge and Baby Bridge you will pass the ancient goldmill ruins of Bushiribana - always worth a good picture! Alongside the rough coast of the northern part of Aruba you will feel the power of the ocean breaking ashore. And on we go to the next landmark - the California Lighthouse on the northwestern tip of the island, accurately restored to its original version of 1910. BARBADOS


Warm, welcoming and uniquely atmospheric with something for every kind of traveller, Barbados is justifiably famed for stunning beaches and brilliant turquoise bays spread all around its tropical shores. There are plenty of reasons to leave the beach though. With a Unesco World Heritage listed capital and delicious Bajan cuisine around every corner no wonder travelers quickly discover that it's the kind of place they want to return to time and again.

Starting with the historic Bridgetown sites, we drive by Kensington Cricket Oval, one of the major stadiums in the Caribbean. Passing Rihanna's house and neighbourhood, we head to Batts Rock Beach then on to St. James Parish Church. Visiting Speightstown, also known as Little Bristol where old and new exist harmoniously side by side.

Continuing from Port St. Charles to Port Ferdinand Marina and Luxury Resort, we will see the entrance to Animal Flower Cave, a natural wonder named for the sea anemones that live in the cave's shallower pools. We finish with a meander along the beautiful, rugged Atlantic Coast.

BARBADOS HIGHLIGHTS WITH AIRPORT TRANSFER

A full island tour finishing at the airport in time for your departure. We meander along the bustling South coast, through the historic Garrison Savannah, into Bridgetown and up along the Western Gold Coast, where the settlers arrived, stopping off at charming and quaint old Speightstown. We then make our way north and up to take in the breathtaking view from Cherry Tree Hill and enjoy drinks and some souvenir shopping.

Continuing we head down into the view, past Morgan Lewis windmill (the last operating windmill on the island) en route to beautiful Bathsheba along the rugged coastline of the eastern side of the island. After a visit to Bathsheba we head for St. John's Church, the most visited church on the island, which sits at an elevation offering a commanding view of the island. Drinks are also served here before heading to the south east of the island, through the sea of green sugarcane swaying in the breeze as we make our way back south through the countryside finishing at the airport for your departure after a truly a well rounded day that covers every facet of this jewel of an island.

Lunch is not included in this tour, but for great local food the Fisherman's Pub in Speightstown is famous and very reasonable – around \$10-15 US for lunch.



BATHSHEBA AND HUNTE'S GARDENS TOUR

After a short island tour along the rugged and beautiful east coast we will make a photo stop at Bathsheba before carrying on to explore 'the most enchanting place on earth'. The garden is a constant work in progress, started in the 1950s by horticulturist Anthony Hunte who has transformed a former sinkhole-like gully into a magical, breathtaking place, bounded by tall palms and featuring an array of tropical flowers, trees and foliage, statues, antiques and other beautiful decorative pieces.

This beautiful place holds an appeal for all who wish to be mesmerized by nature's beauty, it does not reveal all of its secrets at once and you will lose yourself in its captivating pathways. If you are fortunate enough to meet Mr Hunte in person, he will chat with you over a cup of tea (or feisty rum punch!) like an old friend.

OISTINS FISH FRY

Best suited for passengers on Saturday flights, the Friday night fish fry at Oistins Bay Gardens is a must-do in Barbados! In a very informal setting excellent fish, lobster, chicken etc are all cooked on the spot in front of you.

Main choices are - chicken, Marlin, tuna, kingfish, mahi-mahi, shrimp, swordfish, snapper and flying fish, with sides of rice and peas, macaroni pie, steamed vegetables, sweet potatoes, garlic potatoes, French fries, plantain and grilled potatoes alongside tossed salad, pasta salad and coleslaw.

HARRISON'S CAVE

A unique phenomenon of nature and one of the island's greatest wonders. A massive stream cave system at least 2.3 kilometres long, this crystallized limestone cave is an amazing gallery of stalactites and stalagmites with streams of crystal-clear running water that drop from breathtaking waterfalls to form deep emerald pools. The largest cavern, the Great Hall, measures 15 metres high.

The tram tour is the most popular, with visitors driven in electrically operated trams down through the extensive system of caves. Walking tours and a special Eco tour for the adventurous are also available.

The Titou Gorge (small throat) is a narrow short swim through a series of natural rooms and ponds formed by high cliff walls canopied by interlaced trees leading to a hidden waterfall! A scene from the film series Pirates of the Caribbean was also filmed here. A 10 minute walk takes you to one of the most popular sites in Dominica, the Trafalgar Falls. It's a well maintained footpath from the visitor center to the viewpoint for a panoramic view of the twin falls which plunge about 125ft and 75ft respectively.

For the adventurous a 10 minute rock climb from the viewpoint takes you to a naturally hot and cold pool formed by the falls. Enjoy the view of natural hot springs at boiling point and mud pools that are believed to have medicinal qualities. They also offer a relaxing and reviving experience after a long day. There is no better natural medicine to soothe sore muscles or calm jittery nerves than settling into the springs' natural muddy water (Baths are optional and cost an additional US\$10pp).





MARTINIQUE

Volcanic in origin, Martinique is crowned by the still-smouldering Mont Pelée, which famously wiped out the former capital of St-Pierre in 1902. An overseas region of France, the culture reflects a distinctive blend of French and West Indian influences with French the official language though Creole is widely spoken - don't expect to hear a great deal of English. Black sand beaches and rainforests are found in the north, with yet more beautiful sands to the south.



RAINFOREST & CARIBBEAN TOUR

After a short tour round Fort-de-France, the capital of the island, to show you all the different monuments we will head north by the Route de la Trace, the rainforest road, and stop at the Balata sacré coeur (a replica of the Sacre Coeur in Montmartre, Paris) and enjoy a beautiful panoramic view of the city and the South of the island. After this we will head through the rainforest and stop at Absalon Waterfall and Alma River where bathing is possible.

We will continue up to Le Morne-Rouge and have a look at the Mount Pelee volcano. Our last stop will be at Rhum Neisson distillery, a family business in which unique know-how is passed down from generation to generation. After learning about the production process you will be able to sample the renowned products.

We will return along the Eastern side of the island passing fishing villages on our way back.





ST KITTS

With jaw-dropping scenery, including everything from picture perfect beaches to lush rainforest, more than a quarter of the island is designated national park, which is mostly made up of rainforest. The local culture is mellow, friendly and relaxed.



BEST OF ST KITTS - FULL ISLAND TOUR

In 'The Circus' you will see the Berkeley Memorial, a replica of the clock in Piccadilly Circus in London. ST LUCIA


Always evocative, the only sovereign nation to be named for a woman, St Lucia welcomes visitors with her soothing waves, warm beaches, lush valleys of coconut and banana plantations and hospitable people. The coast is home to volcanic beaches, reef diving sites, luxury resorts, fishing villages and the dramatically tapered Pitons in the west. Trails in the interior rainforest lead to spectacular waterfalls like the 15m high Toraille. Visitors invariably find themselves reluctant to leave and eager to return.



DUTCH AND FRENCH TOUR

At the end of this tour, you will have experienced the island and learned some of its history and culture - there is no beach visit!Driving around the Great Salt Pond we will continue through Fort Willem for a great view of Philipsburg and one of our historical forts, Fort Amsterdam, built by the Dutch in 1631 on a peninsula that juts out between Great Bay and Little Bay. Next take incredible photos and enjoy amazing panoramic views of Dutch St. Maarten from the top of Harold Jack Hill lookout point between Cole Bay and Philipsburg. You can spot the Caribbean islands of Saba, St. Eustatius, and Anguilla in the distance. Then we will drive along Simpson Bay Village, past the Yacht Club where the million dollar yachts are docked and the Simpson Bay Fish Market, where local fishermen land their catch.

St Martin is a dual culture island, with the French part in the north, and the Dutch in the south, we will stop for you to take pictures of the imaginary line that separates them, then on to the French capital, Marigot. Visiting Marigot also means tasting the charm of local products in a traditional Caribbean atmosphere - the town has rows of patisseries that sit side by side with smart bistros. We will have a stop of 1hr 15min, so you can browse the local merchant markets and purchase local products, spices, clothing, jewelery etc.

Moving on, overlooking Marigot Bay and facing Anguilla is the largest historical monument in St.Maarten, named after King Louis XVI of France, who built a settlement to protect Marigot during his reign. To access Fort Louis you must climb the 91 steps that will take you to the top of the Fort. Continuing, we will drive through Grand Case village and on to Paradise view, a panoramic view overlooking Orient Bay, Pinel Island, Tintemarr and St Barts. After this we will pass through the largest village on the French side of the island, Quartier d'Orleans.

Last stop is the capital of St Maarten, Philipsburg, on the Dutch side of the Island. Beachfront bars line the boardwalk long the Great Bay seashore. Voorstraat, or Front Street, has duty-free shops, jewelry stores, electronic stores, and a historical landmark The Philipsburg Courthouse. The tour will end with the option to walk back to the ship.

You will learn a little about the history of beer and our story and participate in our trivia questions for a chance to win prizes. Our tour information takes place in the Tap Area and depending on safety and our production/cleaning schedules, a walk through the production area is possible. After the tour you will have time to browse the gift area or to enjoy some time at the bar. This beer is so good that we locals are now calling it our national beer.

Now that you all are tipsy - except the driver, we will take a 5-minute drive to the Tap and Still for the best burgers in the world. Ooooweeee - we can tap and still be friends is their slogan, but their burgers will make you want more. You will order during the bus ride so when you get there just have a seat and prepare for lift off. Amazing juicy burgers, special homemade fries and oh yeah, they serve SXM BEER. Let us know if you are vegetarian or allergic to any food and we will make your burger right.

Heaven won't be complete without a beach. You can choose to relax at Kimsha beach which is 10 steps away from The Tap and Still or be entertained by planes landing and taking off right over your head at Maho Beach then try your luck at the Casino close by.





ST VINCENT



ATLANTIC ADVENTURE

Exploring the highlights of the Atlantic side of Tobago, first visiting Fort King George, a National Trust Grade 1 listed property completed in 1779. Next stop will be Argyle Waterfall, a spectacular cascade of cool, crisp water that falls 54m down three dramatic levels. The waterfall is accessed by a 15-20 minute trek along a clearly marked trail along which you are greeted by butterflies and a variety of birds. Ambitious hikers can take a bushy path on the right to the second level where you are met by a thick mist and can lie in several natural rock tubs and let the water rush over your body. The third and smallest pool is the deepest and best for swimming, inviting you to dive, jump or swing into the water from available vines.




